Spring Really is Here!

Spring certainly came early this year! if you haven't already done your Spring Cleaning; don't forget your patios and balconies. Remember your patio or balcony is a limited common area. This means the association controls the use of them. The only items allowed are gas grills, patio furniture and plants in flower containers. NO toys, NO bikes, NO indoor furniture, NO mops or brooms, NO bags of charcoal. Please remember that nothing can hang over the railings. Do not attach anything to the brick walls, or the ceiling or the concrete floors. If you wish to cover the the floor, remember you can only use green Astro Turf and it cannot be glued down. All patios and balconies must be in order by May 31st.

From The City of Prospect Heights

The city of Prospect Heights has new precaution measures against fires. Open flame cooking devices like BBQ units must be located at least ten feet away from your patio doors. The Association is asking all residents to place BBQ equipment in the farthest corner of your patio or balcony away from your doors. This precaution is for your safety. Please remember that you cannot use liquid starting fluid because it is hard to control. You will need to get an electric starter.

Pool Tags Recalled

If you have a pool tag that has a black & white photo on it, you need to bring it to the Lake Run office. Also bring in a color photo for your new Pool Tag. Pool tags with a black & white photo will only be good until May 31st.

Speaking of Balconies

Please check your balcony railings. Please check for an accumulation of rust or for loose railings and contact the Lake Run office. Mayra will send someone to fix your railings. Your balcony is a limited common area so this is at no cost to you.

Satellite Dishes

We have been negotiating with several dish companies, but until we settle on one we must maintain the integrity of our complex. Please be sure that your dish is not connected to any part of your balcony or patio, it must be painted to match the brick of the

building (paint is available in the office) and staked in concrete (in a flower pot is nice).

No Smoking

If you are a smoker please be careful with your cigarette butts. Do not throw them over your balcony railings onto the balconies, patios or lawn below. Be kind to all who come thru the entrances and do not litter there either. The association has supplied ash containers for this purpose.

Flowers & Plants

In the Summer the flowers look so beautiful. The Association encourages everyone to decorate your patios and balconies. In the past the complex just glows in color and kind.

Those of us who have patios please remember that you cannot plant anything beyond your concrete area. The landscapers will remove anything that has been planted outside the patio area.

Your Most Precious Treasure

Children should not be unattended at any time. We do discourage children from playing in the parking lot. Also, children should not be playing by the Lake. Please tell your children that this is very dangerous. Stones that are around the Lake are not to be picked up and thrown. The management office will be starting to bring unattended children to the office and they will have to be bailed out by their parents. Small children in small electrical cars are almost invisible to someone in a regular size car. Please make sure that you and your children are wearing light colors or reflective strips at night or when it is dark.

Remember the speed limit in the parking lot is 15 mph.

More About The Parking Lot

Please do not throw garbage from your vehicle into the parking lot. There are proper containers provided for this disposal. Please use them. Remember doing maintenance on your car is a violation .

Bike Rooms

We have bike rooms in the basement. Bikes must be kept in the Bike Rooms or your units (NOT on your patio or balcony). If you choose to keep it in your unit remember you cannot bring your bike up in the elevator. There is no riding of bicycles, scooters, wagons or roller skates in the hallways or lobbies.

Cell Phones & The Entry System

All residents who have area codes other than 847, 224, 708 or 312 on their cell phones used for the entry system will have to change their phone numbers. This means NO out of state phone numbers. Please make sure that your phone number has the correct area code.
